Rethinking Prophecy Timing

Greetings, everyone! Welcome to Sabbath services! How many of you were in the Church in the 1960s? We had one famous booklet: 1975 in Prophecy, all wonderfully illustrated with the most gruesome pictures by Basil Wolverton.

There was a constant pounding of articles saying that if you're in the true Church of God you'll go to a place of safety. So much so that people even had—since they determined it was going to be at Petra—their Petra boxes, everything they needed, in the trunk of their car in case they were to flee on the Sabbath because they didn't want to be without what they needed. They didn't read the Scripture that said, 'Don't let your flight be on the Sabbath.'

So then, as we progressed through the 1960s there were the riots, fires in the cities and all of these things. Everybody was getting excited that, yes, it sure looks like it's going to 1972 that we will flee and the end of the world is going to be 1975.

Well, lo and behold, those riots and the burning of the cities stopped and things got more back to normal. They had a hard time explaining why they were wrong. I remember in the Auditorium the Sabbath before we were to flee, which was to be the first Sunday in January. We were told by 'the apostle in chief' that 'we may go to a place of safety next week and we may not, but we probably will.'

That first Sunday in January passed and the next Sabbath there was a great announcement: Instead of going to Petra, the place of safety, we are now going to be advertising in the *Reader's Digest*. That was the replacement for going to a place of safety. You always have to have another doctrine to compensate for your mistake.

Let's fast forward to the early 2000s: Once a year I would take a trip to Texas. At that time we had quite a few people come and attend on that occasion and I would stay at the house of Jack and Betty Thomas. I think this was on a Thursday morning and came down for breakfast and Betty said, 'I'd like you to do something for me.' What is that? 'I would like you to write down 1975.' The question was about 7,000 years, and the doctrine had been through the Church for so many years that God gave 6,000 years to man, based upon the Scripture that says, 'With God a thousand years is as a day, and a day is a thousand years.' One of the Apocrypha books said that God gave man 6,000 years. That was written 2,000 years-plus, maybe 2500 years, before 1975.

Betty said, 'I would like you write down 1975. Then I would like you to write down 4,025, because 4,024—when you do the chronologies—is when creation was finished for mankind. Could you please add those up for me.'

I added it up and it was 6,000 years. So, here we are in the early 2000s—2002 or 2003—and she didn't say anything, but now how do you explain that? Then I had to explain, well, we began preaching about 1969 that it probably would not be.

So, another person came along and said, 'All right, out of that 6,000 years did God deduct the 70-year captivity of the Jews in Babylon?' Oh, if you add 70 years to 1975 you come up with 2045. Now you're getting closer to what Isaac Newton figured out at 2060.

When things like this come up we need to *rethink* the prophecies. God is right and our understanding is lacking. We're going to look at the nations of the world, equate that to what's going on today, and see if we can understand some of the timing. Most of the timing is not exact day-to-day or year to year. Most of it is by event.

Paul was taken up to Mars Hill where all the great philosophers of Greece were at that time. They were always discussing their theories and they heard Paul talking about the resurrection of the dead.

Acts 17:22: "Then Paul stood in *the* center of Mars Hill *and* said..."—because they said, 'We want to hear you. What is this resurrection of the dead? We've never heard that before.' They believed in the immortal soul, and they also believed in evolution, too.

So, Paul said, "... 'Men, Athenians, I perceive *that* in all things you are very reverent to deities; for *as* I was passing through and observing the objects of your veneration, I also found an altar on which was inscribed, "To an unknown God." So then, He Whom you worship in ignorance *is* the One *that* I proclaim to you. He *is* the God Who made the world and all things that *are* in it...." (vs 22-24).

They had different gods that made different things and demigods and things like this, and their theory of creation, in addition to evolution.

"...Being *the* Lord of heaven and earth, He does not dwell in temples made by hands; nor is He served by the hands of men, as *though* He needs anything, *for* He gives to all life and breath and all things. And He made of one blood all the nations of men to dwell upon all the face of the earth, having determined beforehand *their* appointed times and the

boundaries of their dwelling; in order that they might seek the Lord, if perhaps they might feel after Him and might find Him; though truly, He is not far from each one of us, for <u>in Him we live and move and have our being</u>..." (vs 24-28). That's a very important thing to always remember.

Sidebar: I watched an interview by Megyn Kelly with one of the Koch brothers, Charles Koch. It was very good, because what you will find is that every honest man who is successful follows the principles in the Bible. His principle was that you need to fail to learn how do things right! One of his principles was that you never—when you accomplish something—get all excited and vaunted up over it. Humility was a key, and his book was Good Profit. I'm interested to see...

He and his brother took a company that their father gave them—and he made them work; they weren't spoiled little rich brats—but when the father died the company was worth about \$100-million. Between their efforts today, it's now worth \$100-billion and he's one of the richest men in the world. Everybody is after him, all the democrats, all the liberals.

He gives a lot of money to Republicans and Megyn Kelly asked him, 'Why do you give to Republicans?' He said, 'Because they are the only politicians that follow—not all but most all of them do—basic principles of work, truth and honesty.

This is summarized by this verse, because, v 28: "For in Him we live and move and have our being; as some of the poets among you also have said, 'For we are His offspring.' Therefore, since we are the offspring of God, we should not think that the Godhead *is* like that which *is made* of gold, or silver, or stone..." (vs 28-29).

- Where was Paul standing? Right on Mars Hill!
- What was on Mars Hill? The pantheon! The temple for Zeus with all of the statues and all of the story of...

All of that describes to the Greeks how Greece came to be, through the gods. Here's Paul standing right there saying,

"...gold, or silver, or stone—a graven thing of art *devised by the* imagination of man; for *although* God has indeed overlooked the times of this ignorance, He now commands all men everywhere to repent" (vs 29-30).

Gen. 11 tells us when God put all men in their national inheritances. Of course, they did not

have modern means of travel as we have today, so wherever you lived on the earth, that's pretty well where you were born, grew up and you lived and died. There was some travel; there was some trade and things like this as time went on. This is when they were scattered because the people were one, one language and wanted build a tower to heaven.

Genesis 11:7: "Come, let Us go down and there **confuse their language**, so that they cannot understand one another's speech.' So, the LORD scattered them abroad from that place upon the face of all the earth. And they quit building the city" (vs 7-8). God sent them out!

There's another thing concerning where and what kind of inheritance they would have. That depends on Shem, Ham and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and their obedience to Noah and God, or the disobedience to Noah.

What happened was, Genesis 9:20: "And Noah began *to be* a husbandman, and he planted a vineyard. And he drank of the wine and was drunk..." (vs 20-21).

This took many years. You have Noah's grandson, Ham's son—Canaan—who did the dastardly deed. From that day to this day all the descendants of Ham and Canaan are on the lowest rung of the societal and national structure of the world. That's God's decision.

God does expect those who have more to help them, to show them the right way, but we will see there are also certain national characteristics that blend into what we will talk about in Dan. 2 to make any mass organization of world government fragile.

Here's what happened, v 24: "And Noah awoke from his wine..." Drank a little too much I suppose, getting through the Flood, having to put up with all the animals. I think most of them hibernated during that year that they were on the ark. By the way it was a leap year according to the Calculated Hebrew Calendar—385 days.

"...and learned what his youngest grandson had done to him. And he said, 'Cursed *be* Canaan. He shall be a servant of servants to his brothers.' And he said, 'Blessed be the LORD God of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant. God shall enlarge Japheth... [where all the Orientals come from] ...and he shall dwell in the tents of Shem, and Canaan shall be their servant.'" (vs 24-27).

Sidebar: I saw a very interesting analysis by a Japanese industrialist. He said that almost all of the inventiveness in the world comes from the Anglo-Saxons, which then are Israelites. However, 'We Japanese take what has been invented and we improve upon it, and we make it better.' That's exactly what the Japanese did.

Look at all the inventions, the major inventions of the world: European and American. That doesn't mean that they don't have their sins. That doesn't mean that they are superior or better than any other human being. But God has decided the structure of the races in the nations where He put them. This becomes important in understanding some of the things at the end-time.

We know that right after that, we have Gen. 12 and the calling of Abram, who became Abraham. God promised him:

Genesis 12:1: "And the LORD said to Abram, 'Get out of your country, and from your kindred, and from your father's house into a land that I will show you." That's New Testament doctrine. You forsake everything of this world.

Verse 2: "And I will make *of* you a great nation. And I will bless you and make your name great. And you shall be a blessing. And I will bless those that bless you and curse the one who curses you. And in you shall <u>all families</u> of the earth be blessed.'.... [down to smaller sized groups and nations] ...Then Abram departed, even as the LORD had spoken to him. And Lot went with him...." (v 2-4). The blessings came to Abraham and his descendents and we'll see why.

Let's look at a mistake. What was that mistake? When God first promised the covenant in Gen. 15, Abram started out and said, 'You haven't given me any children, so, how about Eliezer my servant? Let him be my heir.' God said, 'No, you will have a son from you own loins.' That didn't happen until he was 100-years-old. In that instance, Abraham was trying to further along God's promise in Gen. 12; 'You haven't given me any son; how about him?' After that, when he was 85-years-old he got the promises.

Genesis 16:1: "Now Sarai, Abram's wife, did not bear him any children. And she had a maidservant, an Egyptian, and her name was Hagar."

So, let's help the prophecy along. You take my handmaiden and you have children by her. Abraham should have said, 'No! God said it will be from us,' but he didn't. How's that been with the world from that time unto this? Because he followed his wife's advise—there were times she gave him good advice but this was not good advise—Hagar became pregnant and bore Ishmael. Let's see the result of that. Hagar tried to run away from Sarai and the Lord told her, 'You go back and submit yourself.'

Verse 11: "And the angel of the LORD said to her, 'Behold, you are with child, and shall bear a son. And you shall call his name Ishmael because the LORD has heard your affliction. And he will be

a wild man. His hand will be against every man, and every man's hand against him. And he shall live in the presence of all his brothers'" (vs 11-12).

That's the nature of the Arabs. God said it would be! That's not a condemnation. Their challenge in life is to admit that this is true and teach their people how they should manage their lives without getting carried away and being wild. They didn't do it.

Likewise with the blessings to Jacob. Sometimes God works things out so when viewed from a human perspective, an antagonist will not accept what God has said. What happened? *The birthright was promised to Jacob but Esau was the firstborn!* It was prophesied that Jacob would rule over Esau. It worked out that Esau sold his birthright to Jacob. Jacob bought it for a bowl of red soup, lentils.

Here again Rebecca, Jacob's mother—mother gets into it again—says, 'Jacob. I'll fix it up so you can get the blessing. I'll fix up some venison stew just like Esau fixes. We'll take goat's hair and we'll put it on the top of your hands and put it on the back of your neck and you wear Esau's clothes. You go in to your father, Isaac, who's had a hard time seeing lately, and tell him that you're Esau so you get the blessing.

He got the blessing even though the father said, 'Who are you?' *Esau your firstborn!* 'The voice sounds like Jacob.' Then he felt his hands and his neck and he said, 'You feel like Esau.' He was wearing the clothes of Esau and Jacob said, 'Here my father, eat your stew.'

Isaac said, Genesis 27:24: "And he said, 'Are you truly my son Esau?' And he said, 'I am." He lied!

- Why did God do it that way? I don't know, but God did!
- Was he repaid for lying, later by his father-in-law Laban_[transcriber's correction]? *Yes!*

Jacob bargained for his wife Rachael. What happened, Laban_[transcriber's correction] the father slipped in the firstborn girl Leah. After they had all the wine and all this thing, go to consummate the marriage and guess who was in the marriage tent? *Leah!* So, he got compensated for his lies by his father-in law.

Then, Isaac ate it. Verse 26: "And his father Isaac said to him, 'Come near now and kiss me, my son.' And he came near and kissed him. And he smelled the smell of his clothing, and blessed him, and said, 'See, the smell of my son is as the smell of a field which the LORD has blessed. And may God give you of the dew of heaven, and of the fatness of the earth, and plenty of grain and wine. Let people

serve you, and let nations bow down to you. Be lord over your brethren, and let your mother's sons bow down to you. Cursed *be* everyone that curses you, and blessed *be* he that blesses you" (vs 26-29). That's an expansion of the blessing that God gave to Abraham.

He no sooner got out of there than here comes Esau. Isaac said, 'Who are you?' Esau said, 'I'm your firstborn Esau. I come for my blessing.' Isaac said, 'Too late. I already gave it to Jacob.' Hatred, viciousness, retribution and all of those things came out with Esau.

Verse 38: "And Esau said to his father, 'Have you but one blessing, my father? Bless me, even me also, my father.' And Esau lifted up his voice and wept. And Isaac his father answered and said to him, 'Behold, your dwelling shall be far from the fatness of the earth and far from the dew of heaven from above. And you shall live by your sword and shall serve your brother. But it shall come to pass that when you shall have the dominion, you shall break his yoke from off your neck" (vs 38-40). Remember that phrase.

Verse 41: "And Esau hated Jacob because of the blessing with which his father had blessed him.... [because it was the opposite of what the blessing was for Jacob] ...And Esau said in his heart, 'The days of mourning *for* my father are at hand—then I will kill my brother Jacob."

Why did Isaac, who was the father of Jacob, receive the blessing of Abraham?

Genesis 26:5 "Because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws"

The Arabs and Esauites know who they are, but they don't want to admit that they're really like they're described in the Bible. Yet, it happens in every generation and we're going to see—when we get a little bit into the next segment of this message—the political hatred of Islam! You're going to be absolutely surprised; it is unreal!

We're going to do a little survey of Dan. 2, because we need to look at events, not timing. We will see in the book of Daniel that there are some things that are given with lengths of time; there are other things that are not. They're only given by events.

All of those blessings of the twelve tribes of Israel were what they would be in the later days, the last days, Genesis 49:1: "And Jacob called to his sons and said, 'Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you what shall happen to you in the last days.""

Dan. 2—head of gold, chest of silver, then brass, then iron and then iron and clay. {note chart

of all of these in Dan in the back of *The Holy Bible* in *Its Original Order*, A Faithful Version in the chronology section}

Daniel 2:41: "And whereas you saw the feet and toes, part of potters' clay and part of iron, *the* kingdom shall be divided. But there shall be in it the strength of the iron, because you saw the iron mixed with miry clay. And *as* the toes of the feet *were* part of iron and part of clay, *so* the kingdom shall be partly strong and partly broken" (vs 41-42).

That is a perfect description of all the nations of the world today. The ten toes represent *ten regions* of the world that have been devised by those pushing for a world government. They've had different ways of doing it, like: North America, South America, Europe, Russia, China; they have them all numbered out into *ten regions*.

Verse 43: "And whereas you saw iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mix themselves with the seed of men. But they shall not cling to one another, even as iron does not combine with clay."

We saw that when we had the earthquake, especially the earthquake in 1988 when the freeway collapsed. What happened? It was so strong it just ripped the concrete away from the iron reinforcing bars within the pillars that hold up the freeway! That's like hardened clay with iron and when there's stress on it, it will break.

Verse 44: "And in the days of these kings, the God of heaven shall set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed. And the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand forever."

It takes us clear down to the end of time. How long was that period? When it started with Nebuchadnezzar you wouldn't know! Likewise, we can just say:

- Dan. 3—type of one world religion
- Dan 4—the epistle of Nebuchadnezzar to all the leaders of the world

That should be read in the United Nations!

- Dan 5—has to do with the fall of Babylon and it fell that night
- Dan. 7:
 - ✓ four beasts, they're all listed out there
 - ✓ then you have it coming to the end of the age
 - ✓ you see how God explains the four beasts: the fourth one with seven heads and ten horns

Daniel was watching this until:

Daniel 7:22: "Until the Ancient of Days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the Most High.... [Kingdom of God] ...And the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom. Thus he said, 'The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be different from all the *other* kingdoms and shall devour the whole earth, and shall trample it and break it in pieces. And the ten horns out of this kingdom *are* ten kings that shall arise. And another shall arise after them. And he shall be different from the first, and he shall subdue three kings" (vs 22-24). That's all listed in the chart in the back of the Bible.

Verse 25: "And he... [this is the coming beast (Rev. 13)] ...shall speak words against the Most High, and shall wear out the saints of the Most High, and think to change the set times and the laws. And they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and one-half time"—three and a half years. If you stretch it out, some people liken that to 1,260 days and some people liken that to 1,260 years. It's possible it fits in different categories, but since this is the end when Christ returns, it's probably the three and a half year period.

Verse 26: "But the judgment shall sit, and his dominion shall be taken away to be consumed and to be destroyed unto the end. And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High..." (vs 26-27). We possess the kingdom, the eternal kingdom, the end. Again, it doesn't tell us exactly when.

Dan. 8 talks about the Medes, the Persians and the Greeks with Alexander the Great, Daniel 8:19 "And he said, 'Behold, I will make you know what shall happen in the latter time of the indignation, because it belongs to the appointed time of the end." There is an appointed time; *God's* appointed time, not *our* appointed time.

Verse 20: "The ram which you saw having two horns *are* the kings of Media and Persia. And the shaggy goat *is* the king of Greece. And the great horn between his eyes is the first king. Now, that being broken, then four stood up in its place; four kingdoms shall stand up out of the nation, but not with its power" (vs 20-22).

Again, notice how all of these jump ahead to the end-time.

Verse $23_{\text{Itranscriber's correction}}$: "And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors have come to the full, a king, fierce of countenance and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up." What will make him stand up? We will see that that equates to the King of the North! What will make him stand up?

It's been preached for years and years that it's going to come out of Germany. Germany will have part of it but it looks like it's going to have to come out of combined Europe.

Verse 24: "And his power shall be mighty... [compare to Rev. 13] ...but not by his own power.... [because the devil gives him his power, his seat and his authority] ...And he shall destroy marvelously, and shall prosper and do his own will, and destroy the mighty and the Holy people. And also through his cunning he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand. And he shall magnify himself in his heart... [2-Thes. 2] ...and in time of security shall destroy many. He also shall stand up against the Prince of princes. But he shall be broken without a human hand" (vs 24-25). Why? Because he's cast by an angel into the Lake of Fire (Rev. 19)!

Dan. 9—here we have an exact time sequence. The 70 weeks are heptads of seven-year sequences, telling about:

- when Jerusalem would be built
- how long that would be
- how long to the Messiah

Then we have the 70th week. We have Dan. 10 and 11. It gets into the King of the North and the King of the South. That expands into the exalting of the King of the North.

Daniel 11:36: "And the king shall do according to his will. And he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god... [2-Thes. 2] ...and shall speak astonishing things against the God of gods, and shall prosper until the indignation be accomplished, for that which is decreed shall be done. He will not regard the gods of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god, for he shall magnify himself above all. But in his place he shall honor the god of forces... [Who is that? *Satan the devil, directly!*] ...and a god whom his fathers did not know shall he honor with gold and silver, and with precious stones and costly things" (vs 36-38).

Verse 40 talks about events; there is no timing involved. This is where we need to *rethink* what is going on. "And at the time of the end..." How long is the "...time of the end..."? *We don't know!* How does God look at the "...time of the end..."?

"...the King of the South shall push at him..." (v 40). What does it mean to "...push at him..."? The King of the North? We will see part of it in this presentation of political Islam. We'll see how the Muslims have always done.

But what does it mean to "...push..."? Speculation: Is that what we are seeing right now with all the refugees *pushing* into Europe? *Millions* of them! There are some astounding pictures

showing, even from Libya, they load down these boats with over 10,000 people. They get this rusty old hoke into Italy and unload them there in Italy. So, Italy is suffering from it, as well.

It's very interesting that Bulgaria and Hungary threw up wired fences and put guards right along there. Why? Because they were under the Muslim thumb centuries ago and they want nothing to do with it! Could it be that this migration of mostly young men armed with knives are really seeking a betterment of themselves? <u>or</u> Is there another motive involved?

If you've ever seen the pictures of all the junk and garbage they left in the train stations, you will know that they don't care one whit about the Europeans or what they stand for. They just dumped all their junk right in the train stations. It's not like, 'Oh thank you for receiving us. We're trying to save our lives and our families. It's such a wonderful thing for you to help us.' NO! We're coming here and we're demanding of you and you're going to give to us—"...push at him..."

Verse 40: "And the King of the North shall come against him like a whirlwind with chariots and with horsemen and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries and shall overflow and sweep through."

- Could it be there is a lot of time between the 'push' and the later invasion? *Very possible!*
- Could it be that they're going to make themselves so obnoxious that there is going to arise a powerful man who will expel them all back to their homelands?

We even have a United States potential President in the candidacy of Donald Trump who says, 'I'll send them all back.'

How do you think the Germans are going to take this? *They haven't lost their 'superiority gene'!* What if the pope calls upon them to rise to save western civilization?

Comments:

➤ These refugees seeking a peaceful place to be are anything but peaceful. They are obnoxious. They're oppressive!

People who would normally go out and take a walk in the evening, sip a little wine, eat some hors d'oeuvres and things like that, can't even go out anymore.

Maybe the Germans will put them to work because they need younger people to work in the factories. That may work for a time but ultimately, the nature of the people that we read of in Gen. 16 and 27, it's going to happen! If they kill their own at the drop of a hat, what do you think they're going to do to the infidel? Could it be that there could be a great deal of time between the *push* and the subsequent attack? Who knows what's going to happen in the Middle East? It is all up in the air right now!

We're going to watch a special video by a professor of political Islam who gives us the history from $600_{\rm A.D.}$ to the present and then you will be able to make up your own mind.

As I told you on 9/11, I suddenly realized it was my task to make difficult books readable, which is what I have done on the back table. I sometimes describe myself as a man who reads big, thick, old books and writes modern small books that anyone can understand. And actually, I rather enjoy it.

I don't surf the web. People are disappointed when they run into me sometime, and some other

counter Jihadist asks, "Have you seen my website?" No!

I don't even go to my own website. I have very little interest in the web, except for 'Craig's List,' Yahoo Headlines and Drudge. That's it! So, I like reading big, thick, old books. I really do.

I thought when I got my books written in which the Koran was easy to understand, here's Mohammed easy to understand, all these books on Sharia and everything were easy to understand. I thought, "we win." No! We don't even have game. Because, what I discovered was, other than a minority view—and trust me you are so minor—everyone else's reaction to the knowledge, to the answer to the question, "What is the true nature of Islam?" They react in fear, hatred and anger.

When I try to explain to people something about Islam, they are terrified. So, I thought people would run when I got my books published. And, indeed, they did run, away from me.

So, I thought there was just one great question: What is the true nature of Islam? But, I found there was a second question, more important: Why are we afraid to know Islam?

Now, remember when I told you about stories? Here's the thing. My books are factual. They work here [in the mind]. But in dealing with human beings, you are going to make a sale—any salesman will tell you this—the facts are secondary to feelings. And where you get the feelings is from stories, amongst other places.

I began to think about 'why is everyone so afraid, even though they don't know anything. Well, it turns out, they do know little figments of stories about Islam that involve violence. And the knowledge that they were into the slave trade does not come as a shock, really.

So, remember that I told you about the house of Sufism was like a palace with a smell coming up from the basement? Everyone smelled that smell. They just don't want to talk about it. But it's somewhere deep in the back, almost primordial mind.

So, the problem is we don't know the history of Islam. We don't know the answer to this question: This is the World of Islam, how did it happen? You can ask very intelligent people, and they will not be able to give you the answer to this question: How did North Africa go from being European and Christian to being Arab and Muslim? How did that happen? And is that an important question? How did the Middle East go from being Christian to Muslim? And is that an important question? I think it's an overwhelmingly important question.

All right, now to understand how the Islamic world came about, we are going to

have to go about and see how Islam entered our world. Now, to do that, Islam entered the world of the Byzantine Empire. We know that in the Sira, Mohammed's life, his last days were spent killing Christians and subjugating them. After he died that process continued.

So, let's describe the world that Islam invaded. Now, we are told that the Roman Empire collapsed when the German Barbarians invaded Rome. You all heard that story? Well, that's false. That is not true. It is wrong!

What happened was, after the German Barbarian tribes invaded Rome they set up their own version of the Roman Empire. They retained classical culture. They spoke Roman. They hired Roman philosophers and Roman attorneys to teach their children and run their schools. They came into the Roman Empire, not to destroy the empire, but just to get the goods for themselves.

The eastern part of the empire, called the Byzantine Empire is over here. Now this is after the German invasion. The important point is this: They were still a classical empire. it's not collapsed.

Then, after the fall of Rome, the Byzantines gradually exerted their political influence, till now this was the new form of the Roman Empire. This is the Byzantine Empire and it is about to be invaded. This is the classical world that Islam invaded. Notice that the classical world is still up and running. It's critical to remember that. It was now weak but it was still up and running. We are going to see what caused its collapse.

Here we see in 25 years, three stages of development of the spread of Islam. This is 25 years work. How is it that the Arabs were able to do to the Byzantine Empire what the Persians could not do in Iran? Here is the answer to that question: It has to do with Iran, actually. The Greeks and the Persians had been having wars since forever. The 300 at Thermopylae, that was about the Persians. Alexander the Great defeated the Persians. The Persians kept hammering on the Romans and Byzantines and 25 years before Islam invaded there was one massive last series of battles that left Persia weak and the Byzantine Empire very weak.

Then comes along the Black Plague; one person in three dies. So, the Byzantine Empire, when Islam invaded, had been weakened by a long war with Persia and the loss of a third of it's population. The economy had collapsed by two-thirds. You think the Obama economy is bad? Try two-thirds.

So, we had an empire that was weak invaded by a people with a mission. Now, what's important here is, these three different shades of green represent the different caliphs. This Empire, beginning to build here, came from people who could be described as the apostles of Mohammed.

Why is it important to know that? They knew Mohammed. They held his hand. One of them—Ali—married his daughter.

Abu Bakr was his father-in-law. These people are not just brothers in the religious sense. They are brothers in the family sense. They *knew* Mohammed like I know my wife.

And what did they do? Did they go out preaching the Koran? No they didn't. They picked up their swords, got on their camels and horses and went out whacking Christians and Persians.

That is, this is the true nature of Islam! There you see it. This is the fruit on the tree. Massive destruction.

Now, notice something else that has happened here: Egypt is the breadbasket of the Mediterranean. Syria, the heart of the intellectual world in the classical empire.

In 25 years, the classical civilization lost it's ability to feed itself and lost it's biggest brain trust. This destroys classical Christianity. Christianity that we have today is a bloody stump of the original Christianity. Why? This destroyed the heart of it. Transformed it.

The first stage of the annihilation of the classical empire: gone! The heart of it is gone. A century later, notice over here in Spain, 750 A.D., Spain is already Muslim. This is rapid-fire conquest. This is going to become very important because this happened, as it were, in the life of a nation overnight. This brutal assault is the key as to why we fear Islam!

Now then, you are next going to see history that have not heard before. I'm not a historian, but I am a scientist, and I can reason from data.

I knew once I read the story of Mohammed that I had been fed a pack of lies about what caused the Dark Ages. Roman Barbarians didn't cause the Dark Ages. First off, these Barbarians were Germans. These are the same people who made Germany. You tell me they were too stupid to learn how to do Roman law and stuff? Of course not!

They were very intelligent people. They didn't cause the collapse. But that is the classical theory. You go to Vanderbilt, that is what they will teach you.

Here we go with the data. There has recently been a lot of classical ancient works that have been translated into a database format so it can be accessed. There has been massive archaeological research under the ocean and at the edge of the Mediterranean.

From this archaeological research, we're able to track history and economies. That figure that I gave you about how the economy collapsed, that came from the study of sunken vessels. Because, if you're not buying much... Let's say one in ten ships is sunk. That figure is not that high, but whatever.

If you see a lot of sunken ships, there was a lot of ships sailing around. When they go down, the economy goes down. So, from this data we know a lot, and this in particular, the database of ancient documents, gives us 548 battles that Islam fought against the classical world.

This is all new information. I have talked with people who consider themselves history buffs, and they go, "Let's see, battles of Islam against Europe, let's see we've got invasion at Tours, we've got the invasion at Gibraltar, we've got Lepanto, Gates of Vienna. Ok, that's five.

You talk to an historian and those are the five battles they can scratch up. And I remind you, you can have all of these slides if you send me an email for it.

What does this new data show us? It shows us this: See the white spots, they are brand new battles and are going to change to red. The white are new.

I'm going to show you this all over again. Every tic is 20 years. The new battles for that 20-year period come up in white, then they fade to red to show you the history. So, white is what's happening right now, red has happened. Let's see how these 548 battles act out.

We are going to watch in seventy seconds we'll see 1200 years of conquest. Look how fast this is happening. BAM! You didn't know France was hammered that hard, did you? You heard of Tours. Watch what is happening in Spain, in the islands. Now, many of these raids and battles, if they are at the coastline are slave raids.

The slaving that took place in here was extensive and went on and on. All of this work is also happening now. We're into The Golden Age of Baghdad. This is the punishment that's being handed out to Christians everywhere.

After Spain, after one battle, there were knight's heads cut off and they made a pile so high that a man on horseback could not see over them. All of the European civilization in North Africa is now gone!

Now pretty soon, and by the way, there will be a period of time—you can see the clock running up here—there will be a brief blip of five battles that occur in North Africa: The Barbary Pirate Wars. We're on there.

Now then, Byzantium has fallen as Eastern Europe is being hammered. Notice that it is

relentless, it doesn't stop. This is the history that you are never told about. This is the history that explains how all of this came about.

Now then, they're getting slower because Islam is becoming weaker. Corruption? All empires collapse from the inside, ultimately.'

I say that what caused the collapse of classical civilization was not the invading German Barbarian tribes. I say that classical civilization was destroyed by Islam.

Now comes a question: Why do we not want to know that? We are going to answer that question.

Now I want to give you the headlines. With all those little dots, basically what I've showed you is just *quantity*. Relentless, but quantity. We've gave you 1200 years of battles in seve70 seconds, now we're going to go through, in about 4-minutes, I'm going to give you the headlines from each century so you'll know the emotional tone of what is happening.

All right, 7th century: Mohammed sent Khalid out and the sword of Allah to the Jazima tribe to offer Islam, they refused, he annihilated every one of them.

At the Battle of Olayis in Iraq, for two days he spent out rounding up the losers, put them in a dry stream bed and cut off their heads until the stream ran with blood.

He then took the captain of the Zoroastrian Persian tribe; his wife was there. He cut off the man's head, let the blood drain into the soil and raped his wife in the bloody soil. That was one of the companions of Mohammed. This is the nature of jihad. Where did Khalid learn how to do that? From Mohammed! From Mohammed at the Battle of Khaybar.

Umar conquered Jerusalem, and every Jew and Christian became a dhimmi, which is a third-class semi-slave.

For the next few centuries you are going to see The Golden Age. We're taught this myth of The Golden Age: how wonderful Islam is. So, here is what is happening here in The Golden Age:

They started attacking the Sind, which is the Hindus; 26,000 Hindus died. Armenian nobles were herded into a church after a debate and the building burned down on top of them. At Ephesus, 7000 Greeks are enslaved.

We're still in The Golden Age. All new churches were ordered destroyed. At Amorium, there was massive enslavement of all the Christians. The Egyptian Christians revolt over the jizyah, which is the dhimmi tax, based on the Sharia. Churches are burned, villages destroyed.

10th century: we are still in The Golden Age. In Thessalonica, 22,000 Christians were enslaved. Christians massacred in Seville. In Egypt and Syria, 30,000 churches destroyed. "You have your religion; I have mine."

Still in The Golden Age: 6,000 Jews of Morocco killed. Hundreds of Jews in Cordoba killed. 4000 Jews of Granada killed. Georgia and Armenia invaded. In Hindustan 15,000 killed, a half million are enslaved.

Golden Age is still upon us. In Yemen, the Jews are given the choice of convert or die. Christians of Granada are deported to Morocco. In India, many cities are destroyed under the order to convert or die. In one town, 20,000 Hindus became slaves.

Still The Golden Age: 50,000 Hindu slaves decided to get freedom by converting to Islam. A new 20-year campaign created 400,000 new Muslims out of Hindus. Buddhist monks butchered, nuns raped. In Damascus and Safed, mass murder of Christians. Jews of Marrakesh massacred. Tabriz: Forced conversions of Jews.

Still, we're in The Golden Age: There are riots in Cairo. Churches are burned. Jews of Tabriz are forced to convert. Tamerlane, one of the most evil men who ever lived massacred 90,000 Hindus in one day; 30,000 in another battle massacred in India in cold blood. Another Muslim leader takes 180,000 Hindu slaves.

Oops! We're out of The Golden Age; see if you can notice any change in tenor. Tamerlane destroys another 700 villages in India. He then turned to Iraq and annihilated the Nestorian and Jacobite Christians. The Nestorian Christians...half of the silk route from China was Nestorian Christian. The Nestorian Christians had emissaries and missionaries in the Court of China.

Afghanistan was partly Christian. Gone! This is part of the destruction of the church that no one knows about. Seven hundred years of attack, they finally destroy Constantinople.

16th century: The son of Tamerlane destroys temples, forced conversions. Two of his generals built two towers of human heads. Once again, you couldn't see over them. And then noble women, Hindu women, started the practice of suttee, which was mass suicide in order not to become sex slaves inside of the sultans harem.

17th century: Jews of Yemen and Persia forced to convert. Forced conversion of Greeks and Zoroastrian are persecuted in Persia and over half million Hindus killed.

18th century: more Zoroastrian persecution, Jews of Jedda are expelled, Jews of Morocco are massacred, Hindu persecution continues.

19th century: More forced conversion of Jews, Jews of Baghdad massacred. Oops! Quarter-million Armenian Christians slaughtered in Turkey.

Now then, in Persia the Zoroastrians are completely annihilated.

<u>20th century</u>: Over one million Armenian Christians are killed. One million.

So, you now not only know the number of battles, you now see the tenor of what's going on. You now know *quality and quantity*. Do you get the drift on how bad this was?

Now then, the establishment doctrine is that classical collapse had nothing to do with Islam, and indeed, Islam was a source of good because the hillbilly Europeans lost their classical learning and the shrewd, smart Arab Muslims preserved all the knowledge in The Golden Age.

This is what is taught in our schools! I maintain that it was annihilated by Islam.

We've been talking about land here. I now want to talk about *water* because classical civilization was based upon the Mediterranean Sea. Egypt was part of the Mediterranean world. It was not part of the African world, because to go from Alexandria, Egypt, to Nigeria was a lifetime. But you get on a ship and can be there in 10 days.

Does this make sense? It was cheap transportation. You could haul a ton of grain from Egypt to Rome for as much as it cost to send 75 miles by ox cart.

This is important. I'm going to be driving back on the interstate after I finish talking here. I do not expect to be attacked or shot at, on the way. I presume that the interstate is safe travel. It used to be that way under the Roman peace. That ended!

The importance of naval work, as many as 500 boats could be in the harbor at Constantinople. The collapse of the freedom at sea.

Let me show you something. We know this from history. The data: Rome used to communicate with France by boat. After Islam, they went over land through the Alps. Why did they do that? There was no longer freedom of the sea.

Here's interesting: the Black Plague was a known problem in the Mediterranean. It used to take four months to get from here to Constantinople because there was sea trade going back and forth. Well, that was eliminated. So now when there was an outbreak of the Black Plague, it went from harbor to harbor to harbor all around here and it took four years to get to here.

Do you see the point that I'm making? It was that little freedom of trade. As a merchant striking out to do business, you could wind up with your ship gone, your goods gone, and you're in

chains/enslaved. By the way, this cuts down a lot on commerce.

A brag: the Christians couldn't float a plank on the inland sea. What did this do? It isolated Europe. It impoverished Europe.

So, you know the business of the Barbary pirates? You know the business of the Somali pirates? Same! Same! It is the Sunna, the way of Mohammed

There is a famous hadith, which is repeated endlessly in which Mohammed awakes in a dream and he sees his jihadists sailing the inland sea. Islam always practices, where possible, economic warfare. Mohammed attacked caravans.

What was attacked in New York? World Trade Center. This is economic warfare. I am an admirer of Islamic civilizational war methods. They're superior to everyone else's thinking in war. They use everything for war. Everything, including the womb! This was an economic jihad.

There were three: You've heard of The Dark Ages? Well, there were three Dark Ages. One in Europe, one in Turkey and one in North Africa. You weren't told that, were you? I wonder why?

Here we see some ruins. What is the importance of these ruins? Well, they are up and standing. What happened to all the ruins in Rome? Well, the people that were still living there were using them as quarries. They harvested them. The Coliseum remained simply because it was so big.

What does this tell us here? If all this stone is still stacked up? There were no people! The invasion of North Africa was so brutal and so fast that it actually left in the harbor a layer of silt. Here's how that happened:

North Africa used to be farmland, irrigated farmland. The Romans, clever men that they were, put along the roads in North Africa olive trees for shade and for keeping the roads fixed for free. Because what would happened is you would bid on buying a lease for a stretch of Roman road in North Africa. You maintain the olive trees and the road, and you got to keep the olives.

So, the Romans got money from selling the lease and then they got the road fixed for free, and somebody has a business making money. Is this clever or what? That all ended. The invading Arabs were not farmers. They were herdsmen. The people there were Christian, and so therefore, the goat... The average Arab family would own 50 goats. They put their goats out into the fields of the Christians. The Christians, as dhimmis would have no right to protest.

Between death and the erosion of crops, there was produced a layer of silt in the harbors. That's how brutal, hard and fast came this collapse

of the economy in North Africa. What was left for the European economy? Furs, lumber, swords and slaves.

We're now really getting to one of the points where we don't want to know this history. Anybody here, all real proud about how some of your ancestors were taken off a coast in Italy and then put into a harem in North Africa? And now you have children from that who are distant relations? You see, you may have distant relations in the Arab world you don't know about because a million Christians were sold into slavery. And, by the way, the Venetians helped to do that.

And another embarrassing piece of news is this: the Jews were very big in the trans-Mediterranean slave trade.

Nobody comes out of this looking good. No one looks good! You also begin to see, I don't really want to know anything about this history at all. Are you catching on here?

The other thing we are told is so bad about Christianity, and so pitiful about those poor Muslims are The Crusades. Who's ever heard this? Well, the Christian Crusades, that's so embarrassing. Gosh, we went out of Europe and went over there and invaded the Arab lands and then we killed them and hurt them. I've heard preachers wallow in pity about how drastically bad The Crusades were.

First off, Islam destroyed 30,000 churches. The Jews and Christians were Dhimmis. There was infinite brutality against Christians. Christians were fleeing the Middle East. The Byzantine emperor appealed to the pope, "Help us, please."

This was a big thing to do because the Byzantine emperor and the pope did not get along at all. But these were desperate people. What did the pope look out and see? This is the world that he saw in 1100, the time of the first Crusade:

Well, let's see, this much of Spain is Muslim and we're getting our behind kicked on a regular basis. Oh, well, this Christianity is gone. Oops! This Christianity is gone. And look at all the battles in the areas that are still Christian.

Do you see the geopolitical problem the pope was facing here? This was not just some, you know we'll just saddle up our horses and go steal from them Arabs, which is what you are told. This is the political picture.

Now then, let's look at a battle map for the Crusades. Let's be fair, I showed you the jihad map. Now here comes the Crusade battle map. We're almost done! That's it!

Now we're told that the Crusades are the moral equivalent of jihad, and therefore, we need to be ashamed and whine and cry. The Crusades were

defensive. They lasted 300 years and the last one was over 800 years ago.

All the jihad was offensive, lasted 1400 years and is still happening right now. In all probability, some Christians are being slaughtered in Nigeria today.

Now, is this moral equivalence? Why, why, why won't they teach this in a church school? The ministers will stump 'Oh, the Crusades were just so terrible.' No! The Crusades were one of the few times the church put steel in its spine. Then we apologized for it.

Now then, let's go to 'the great benefits of Islam.' We're told about two different Golden Ages. We're told about al Andalus, the wonderful empire in Spain in which there was multicultural peace. Jew and Christian and Muslim all lived together in a Golden Age in Europe. You ever heard that?

This is the battle map of The Golden Age in Andalus. Now, while all this is going on, orders for slaves are being filled. The first slave order out of Spain was the Caliph ordered up 3,000 blonde virgins. They were shipped out of Spain. Battles are going on in which Christian knights die. But notice something here, the Christians won't quit fighting! This is going to take 700 years and is going to be over 150 battles fought. There was more than one Caliph at the time. This was a Caliph in North Africa.

Now then, looking at this, do you understand why when Isabelle and Ferdinand were finally in full power, they told every Muslim in Spain to get out of here? They drove everyone out.

My question for you is this: Was Andalus a multicultural Golden Age or Reign of Terror? I claim it was a Reign of Terror, and it was not a Golden Age at all.

And yes, there were a few people who had it good. The elites had it good. There were some rich Jews and rich Christians that had it good. Otherwise there was constant war and slavery. Christians had to wear robes so that you could tell a Christian from a block away. And a Christian couldn't carry a sword and paid special taxes.

Then we come to the question, "Why aren't we told this story?"

Now we have the Baghdad Golden Age. Here we go! This is all the battles that were fought during the period of The Golden Age in Baghdad. Now, not only are they being as busy as they can in killing Christians, but they're also busy establishing the Sharia doctrine. They are also busy establishing the Hadith doctrine. And they are also busy doing things like slave trading. You know all those exotic photo pictures you've seen of the harem. The sort of pre-Playboy sexy? Beautiful women in gauzy

outfits? All of those women were Christians. Less romantic sounding, isn't it?

The other thing that is happening in Baghdad is this: a new philosophy is being generated in which there is no cause and no effect. This turns out to paralyze the mind.

Those were all the battles that were fought during the mythical Golden Age. During The Golden Age, Christians and Jews were dhimmis. Christians were sex slaves.

Here's one that gets me: During this Baghdad Golden Age there evolved a philosophy in which there were no laws of nature, and there was no cause and effect. I'm a scientist. We work off of two laws: The law of contradiction; does the data contradict the data? And the law of cause and effect.

I've just explained to you why out of The Golden Age you don't find Muslims getting Nobel prizes in science. You cannot be a scientist and not believe in cause and effect! You just can't! It won't work!

Now then, the Christians did all the translation of the vaunted Golden Age texts and, get this: We're told that this was such a great peak of learning? They destroyed 90% of the books.

And we're told the remaining 10% they preserved is like: "Oh, this was The Golden Age. Oh, we live in eternal gratitude to the Muslims." If they hadn't come along, we'd have had 100% of them!

Presented with the library in India, the largest library in the world was a Buddhist library in Nalanda. They came to him and reported they exist after they conquered and they said, "What should we do with the library?" The order from the general was this: "If it contains any information that is in the Koran, we already have it, burn it. If it contains any information that is not in the Koran, it is false, burn it." The same was done with most all of the libraries.

Why are we told this was some wonderful Golden Age that preserved knowledge for us?

Ottoman Empire 1683: The reason I have this up here is Islam in Europe. That's the world today. I now explain to you how this world came about. It came about through relentless, brutal persecution of everyone who was not a Muslim.

Now then, let's change to modern times. All of that work stops in 1922. This works off of a database of 19,000 jihad attacks since 9/11.

Things like this: the date, the country, the city, how many killed, injured, and a description.

When you present a guy like me with 19,000 pieces of data, I start asking questions. How do we make this make sense? So, let's make it make sense.

By the way, you did hear about all these 19,000 attacks in *The Tennessean* in the local paper, didn't you? You did hear about this, it was on the nightly news?

This by the way is where all these took place, if you think that is interesting. You'll notice something. This is the Islamic world and it all centers around it. But notice how much is happening in Europe?

I take the data and I parse it and I divide it. I use Islamic doctrine to analyze this data. What does Islamic doctrine insist on? Well, in my first lecture, I told you they are fixated on the kafir—right? So, I use the kafir to analyze this data from the Islamic standpoint.

See, I'm the ultimate multi-culturalist. No, really. I'm the only person you've ever met that analyzes Islam on the basis of Islam. Here we go. Here we have, in the last ten years, the total number of attacks.

In the green we have Muslim-on-Muslim violence. You mean a Muslim will kill a Muslim? Really? They're doing this is Syria as we speak, right? Remember Iran and Iraq? OK.

Then we have the only one I care about. I mean, my motto here is "sell weapons and intelligence to the loser." I'm very serious; you think I'm joking. Here's our story, right here. It stays pretty level. That's interesting. By the way, there is hardly a day in which there is not a jihad attack.

Modern jihad is relentless and classical. Oh, by the way, one of the things this curve proves right here, Islam is bad for kafirs, Islam is bad for Muslims. Islam is bad for Muslim and non-Muslim. That's what this data shows us. You want to argue with that? Modern jihad is relentless but what did we see in the other battle map? It was relentless.

There are two types of jihad: against kafir and against Muslim. You see, evidently to kill a Muslim. The reason in Syria they are killing other Muslims, they are not *real* Muslims.

Now then, we've introduced however, a new phenomenon: the mom & pop, non-state jihadi shop. All those battles up until 1922 were out of the Caliph. We now have non-state jihad. That is all that is different.

Jihad attacks per year, I just chose the top four nations, but this doesn't really give us what we want because Israel is teeny-weeny and India is great big, so let's do this on per capita:

Now then, Israel? I bet you were surprised about Thailand. You didn't know that Thailand was getting whacked on a regular basis, did you? And look, here's a Christian nation, the Philippines, ranks number three. In India it was Hindu. Oops! Wait a minute! Do you know what? I just told you jihad

was against the Jew, the Buddhist, the Christian and the Hindu. This is the data.

Now you go to these dialogues, these multicultural snoozes that they have with the preacher and the rabbi and the imam show up. The preacher and the rabbi show up to tie, the Muslim shows up to win. And then what does the Muslim tell them? "Oh, the Christians and the Jews, they are the people of the book. Oh, we're brothers in the religion of Abraham with the Christian and the Jew. You know, we're practically the same. We're brothers in Abraham."

How's that stuff work out? Well, here's one of your people of the book. Here's another people of the book. Turns out they'll kill a Jew, a Buddhist, a Christian, or a Hindu just as fast as they will another. So much for being "brothers in the religion of Abraham."

The data does not support the theory, therefore, the theory is wrong! There is no brotherhood of Abraham except in the minds of the people who occupy pulpits. The jihad is against the Jew, the Buddhist, the Christian and the Hindu and the secularists, by the way. The secularists are the worst of all. Well, maybe worse than the Hindu, well it's hard to know; I mean, really. It's against ALL kafirs. That's what the jihad is against.

The Religion of Peace: Here we go: 548 battles, 19,000 jihad attacks, in twelve decades in 1400 years that are jihad free. Therefore, Islam is 91% violence and 9% peace. So, George Bush was 9% right when he declared Islam a religion of peace.

Constant violence is why. There is a doctrine. The doctrine of jihad is found in the Sira, Koran and Hadith. We've already been over this, they don't like kafirs.

We have a whole doctrine of jihad written in the text. Islam was only successful through jihad, therefore, we have a doctrine, which produces jihad and it produces this effect in the collapse of civilizations.

Tears of Jihad: 270-million dead over 1400 years. Read them and weep. The doctrine drives history. History shows the true nature of political Islam. Political Islam is the enemy of all kafir civilizations.

Here's an intellectual history in 1400 years. I've read a lot of old documents. They never talk about the Muslim. They talk about the Arab, the Turk, the Moor, al Qaeda, Asian, and it's always been by specialists. And today, all the establishment specialists are apologists for Islam.

Why was the Koran code not cracked until recently? How come we don't teach Mohammed? And why is The Golden Age propaganda taught? Why do we remain ignorant and keep suffering? I

maintain there is a reason for this. I maintain that this constant brutality over the centuries has produced in the Western mind the equivalent of the abused dog, the beaten wife and the raped child.

We do not think correctly! Anybody seen the beaten dog when you approach it. That is the Western mind. We deny the attacks. How much jihad is ever reported? The churches will not even admit that a Christian suffers anywhere.

<u>Fear</u>: Mohammed used fear. Any public critic of Islam, has a certain fear element there.

Guilt: "Oh, we haven't treated Islam right. If we treated them better, everything would be good."

We don't teach the history. We're humiliated. Who here is going to go home to brag about how your ancestors were slaves, how your history was annihilated and that all we teach is the lie of The Golden Age?

Have you not noticed since 9/11 how bitter and angry politics has gotten? The reason is, we are not allowed to get angry at the enemy. We get cranky with each other. We're powerless. Anybody want to debate about this?

The Abuser: Muslims will not admit they sold a single slave or ever killed a person. They are arrogant and self confident. Islam is perfect. Islam means 'submit.' They expect submission out of us and they get it.

Islam is the victim: After 9/11 I heard this. The real victims of 9/11 were the Muslims. You heard that anywhere?

After 1400 years of jihad brutality and slavery, theft, deception, rape, annihilation and insults the kafir mind has become identical to that of the abused victim.

Our only solution is to face our history and welcome it and embrace it. This is exactly the way we will heal our nation is the way we heal a person who has been brutalized. You have to go back to the original event. *And this is why we are afraid!*

I think it's important that we have seen that and understand what's going on—recent 2012, three years ago. I think this tells an awful lot and *God has always used what are called Muslims today to do His correction against His people!* So, when it says the stranger's going to rise up high above you, think about the invasion into Europe. The *pushing* into Europe. The questions remain:

- How long will they stand for it?
- How long will it take for them to respond like Ferdinand and Isabelle to

- expel all the Muslims back to their countries?
- How much time do we have left in prophecy?

It could be an awful lot of time left. So, we need to look at things, I think, the way that they really are and not the way that we hope they would be.
